\* **2001-2002** – After losing 83 resident students in the 2-3 years prior, CSD restructured the middle/high school for +17.

\*\* **2003-2004** – CSD begins to bring in out of district enrollment numbers into the middle and elementary school to help make up for students from inside our district leaving. This was 5 years before the Charter came to be. Some may recall that Randy Trani was quoted in the Gresham Outlook, in February 2009, that he and Bob Dunton had been discussing the Charter for 5 years. <http://corbettpost.com/csd/charter-school/>

\* **2007-2008** - CSD changed their reporting to a K-12 school with ODE. This change meant we could no longer see a break down of numbers for each grade. As long as CSD brought in more students than we lost, we show growth. The large majority of these new students were non-residents. **Important to note:** Any resident students that left/leave CSD for a private school ( like Open Door or Phonics Factory ) OR that are home schooled, are not tracked in this data at all.

\*\* **2009-2010** – CSD moved 110 non-resident students from ‘in district’ to the newly formed Charter School. CSD added an additional 245 non-resident students to the Charter from a waiting list they had developed according to the Oregonian Article from April 2009. <http://corbettpost.com/csd/charter-school/> The total of 304 students is what was reported for the Charter to ODE. The enrollment number of 608 residents in 2010 is still less students enrolled than we had 10 years prior at the end of 2000. Since then, due to HB3681 and the additional seats created by the opening of the Springdale School, CSD has included many more non-resident students but can now classify them as ‘resident’ due to the change in the law: <http://corbettpost.com/news/house-bill-3681/>

\*\*\* **2011-2012** – The population number of 1,359 is based on the 2012 numbers from ODE ( for both district and charter ) and the Springdale seats at capacity ( 268 ). The current application for population increase ( submitted by Randy Trani to the County in July 2012 ) is asking for 1,890 students ( with Springdale that would mean 2,158 students/staff could be brought in to the District in a “worst case scenario”. ) If we consider only about 500-600 students actually live in our district, then that means there could be 3-4 times the total population attending from out of the area. ### THE CHARTER SCHOOL WAS NOT LEGALLY ESTABLISHED WITH MULTNOMAH COUNTY

From the County’s list of violations for the Corbett middle/high school: “...non-permitted expansion of an existing use through the significant increase in population, traffic flow and traffic patterns without prior County review or approval” ... “and non-permitted increase to student population of the Grade School.” Had expansion been done legally, we would have had a hearing and the chance for public comment to go on record and an opportunity for discussion and a formal traffic study. We would have also realized we were operating outside the conditional use permit for all our buildings. The Voluntary Compliance Agreement was signed by Randy Trani on 4/30/2012. The district must submit a Conditional Use (CU) Permit application to the LUP office by November 24, 2012.
